Judge's Notes: Garnet color. Shy aromas with hints of baked berries, singed cedar, and seared meat follow through on a supple entry to a dry-yet-fruity medium body with char roasted nuts, tomato and herb notes. Finishes with a bright, powdery tannin fade. Pair with roasted duck or hangar steak.
